Director Gregg T. Daniel brings his celebrated artistry to Cape May Stage, with a career spanning award-winning work in theatre and television. Known for his bold storytelling and dynamic staging, Daniel previously directed *The Whipping Man* and *The Mountaintop* at Cape May Stage.

*Dutch Masters* is a timely and unflinching story that asks audiences to confront the walls between us—and imagine what happens when they come down. As Daniel's says in the show's Director's Notes: "Can these two New Yorkers break through the differences to discover the possible ties that bind them?"
